Abstract: Eliminates seizure of property that is alleged to be evidence or is not evidence of a criminal violation.

Present law allows property that is alleged to be or is not evidence of a criminal violation to be seized for forfeiture with or without process issued by any district court on probable cause to believe that the property is subject to forfeiture under present law.

Present law provides for the process and time limitations by which such seizure is to occur.

Present law provides that a seizure without process is reasonable if made under circumstances in which a warrantless seizure or arrest would be reasonable in accordance with law.

Proposed law repeals present law.
