SENATE BILL NO. 339

BY SENATOR BARROW

COSMETOLOGY. Requires a cosmetologist, esthetician, or manicurist in business for themselves or the cosmetology salon owner or mobile salon owner to register their business with the secretary of state. (8/1/22)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 37:599.1, relative to cosmetology; to provide relative to licensure; to provide
3 for registration with the secretary of state; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 37:599.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 **§599.1. Registration with the secretary of state**

7 **Any beauty shop or salon, mobile salon, cosmetologist, esthetician, or**
8 **manicurist who actively practices his licensed profession and owns a business**
9 **shall register their business with the secretary of state.**
