HIGHWAYS/INTERSTATE: Provides for the addition and erection of memorial signage that reads "Drive Safely - In Memory of Kim Cannon" on Interstate Highway 20 east of Exit 44 in Webster Parish

1 AN ACT 2 To provide relative to state highways; to provide for the addition and erection of memorial 3 signage, as a commemoration and a method of increasing public awareness of 4 highway safety, that shall read as follows: "Drive Safely - In Memory of Kim 5 Cannon"; and to provide for related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. The department shall add memorial signage that reads "Drive Safely - In 8 Memory of Kim Cannon" on Interstate Highway 20 east of Exit 44 in Webster Parish. 9 Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are 10 hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation 11 provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's 12 actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to 13 exceed the sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.
