HOMELAND SECURITY OR +\$75,000 GF EX See Note Page 1 of 1  
Requires the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness to adopt certain rules. (8/1/22)

Proposed law directs the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP) to promulgate standards and regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act for an annual emergency preparedness course for the benefit of local officials and members of the legislature prior to January 1, 2023. Proposed law requires the participation of local officials and members of the legislature in this course starting July 1, 2023. Proposed law directs GOHSEP to promulgate standards and regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act regarding disbursement of assets and diversion of resources during a federally or gubernatorial declared emergency.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Proposed law will result in a one-time expenditure of \$75,000 SGF in the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP) to develop an annual emergency preparedness course for elected officials. To implement the proposed law, GOHSEP reports the agency will enter into a one-time consulting services contract for the development of the course. This is a one-time only cost for initial development then GOHSEP will maintain after the completion of the course.

NOTE: GOHSEP would issue a contract for the development of the required annual emergency preparedness course for local officials and members of the legislature. This would include research and analysis of state law, Federal regulations, and GOHSEP internal procedures by the Contractor. Additionally, GOHSEP would require development of the course content manual and development of a PowerPoint and web based training course. GOHSEP would absorb all required printing and course delivery cost. The courses will be online and in-person.

Louisiana Municipal Association indicates that if the training mandates in-person attendance, there would be costs associated with travel for each municipal official required to attend.

**REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
