2	To recognize March 2022 as Problem Gambling Awareness Month in the state of Louisiana.
3	WHEREAS, problem gambling is a public health concern affecting millions of
4	Americans of all ages, races, and ethnic backgrounds in all communities causing a
5	significant societal and economic cost; and
6	WHEREAS, promoting awareness provides individuals in the problem gambling
7	community an opportunity to educate the public and policymakers about the social and
8	financial effectiveness of services available for problem gambling; and
9	WHEREAS, problem gambling is treatable and the treatment is effective in
10	minimizing the harm to both individuals and society as a whole; and
11	WHEREAS, the state offers a myriad of services aimed at treating problem
12	gambling, including educational prevention programs, residential treatment, outpatient
13	counseling, and aftercare programs throughout the state, a toll-free Louisiana Problem
14	Gamblers Help line at 1-877-770-STOP that answers calls from people seeking help with
15	gambling problems, and the www.helpforgambling.org website aimed at the prevention of
16	problem gambling; and
17	WHEREAS, Louisiana was one of the first states to have numerous state-funded
18	programs such as the residential treatment facility, Center of Recovery (CORE) in
