Abstract: Creates the crime of unauthorized removal of a minor from a school, child day care center, or early learning center and provides for the elements of the offense and criminal penalties.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that it shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly and intentionally remove a minor from a school, child day care center, or early learning center when such person is not authorized to do so, including a parent otherwise prohibited from removing the child from a school, child day care center, or early learning center by an order of a court of competent jurisdiction.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for a fine of not more than \$1,000, imprisonment for not more than six months, or both for a first or second offense.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for a fine of not more than \$5,000, imprisonment with or without hard labor for not less than five years, or both for a third or subsequent offense.

<u>Proposed law</u> shall not apply to a minor who leaves a school, child day care center, or early learning center for a sponsored function by the school, child day care center, or early learning center.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> shall only be enforced by the use of summons in lieu of custodial arrest, in accordance with <u>present law</u> (C.Cr.P. Art. 211).

Proposed law provides for definitions for "school", "child day care center", and "early learning center".

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Administration of Criminal</u> Justice to the <u>original</u> bill:
- 1. Redefine the elements of unauthorized removal of a minor from a school, child day care center, or early learning center.
- 2. Redefine the penalties for a first or second offense as well as a third or subsequent

offense.

- 3. Require the use of summons in lieu of custodial arrest for a first or second offense.
- 4. Provide for definitions.
- 5. Make technical changes.
