MEDICAID: Provides relative to parishes eligible for the local healthcare provider participation program

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1248.1(6) and 1248.3(1) and (2), relative to financing by the	
3	state Medicaid program of health services in certain parishes; to provide with respect	
4	to a local healthcare provider participation program; to designate the parishes in	
5	which the program may be operated; and to provide for related matters.	
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:	
7	Section 1. R.S. 40:1248.1(6) and 1248.3(1) and (2) are hereby amended and	
8	reenacted to read as follows:	
9	§1248.1. Definitions	
10	As used in this Subpart, the following terms have the meaning ascribed to	
11	them in this Section:

13	(6) "Rural institutional provider" means a hospital, other than one defined	
14	in R.S. 40:1189.3, that is licensed by the department, has; either had no more than	
15	sixty hospital beds on November 1, 2020, or existed on November 1, 2020 and has	
16	no more than sixty hospital beds; and meets any of the following criteria:	
17	(a) Is located in a municipality with a population of not less than seven	
18	thousand six thousand persons and not more than seven thousand five hundred six	
19	thousand five hundred persons according to the most recent federal decennial census	
20	and in a parish with a population of not less than thirty thousand persons and not

more than thirty-five thousand persons according to the most recent federal decennial census.

(b) Is located in a municipality with a population of not less than ten
thousand nine thousand three hundred persons and not more than ten thousand five
hundred nine thousand eight hundred persons according to the most recent federal
decennial census and in a parish with a population of not less than eighty thousand
persons and not more than ninety thousand persons according to the most recent
federal decennial census.

9 (c) Is located in a municipality with a population of not less than three 10 thousand two thousand nine hundred persons and not more than three thousand five 11 hundred three thousand three hundred fifty persons according to the most recent 12 federal decennial census and in a parish with a population of not less than thirty 13 thousand persons and not more than thirty-five thousand persons according to the 14 most recent federal decennial census.

16 §1248.3. Applicability

17 The provisions of this Subpart shall apply exclusively to the following18 parishes:

(1) Any parish with a population of not less than forty thousand thirty-six
thousand six hundred persons and not more than forty-two thousand thirty-seven
thousand five hundred persons according to the most recent federal decennial census.
(2) Any parish with a population of not less than forty-six thousand persons
and not more than forty-seven thousand forty-eight thousand five hundred persons
according to the most recent federal decennial census.

Abstract: Provides relative to parishes which are eligible for a local healthcare provider participation program within the state Medicaid program.

<u>Present law</u> creates within the state Medicaid program a local healthcare provider participation program for health services financing. Identifies parishes eligible for the program through population range references. Provides that population figures noted are those from most recent federal decennial census.

<u>Proposed law</u> revises <u>present law</u> as necessary to maintain geographic applicability of <u>present law</u> as originally enacted through Act No. 330 of the 2020 RS by updating population range references with figures from the 2020 U.S. Census.

<u>Present law</u> and <u>proposed law</u> apply exclusively to the following five parishes:

- Any parish with a population of not less than 36,600 persons and not more than 37,500 persons according to the most recent federal decennial census (Webster Parish).
- (2) Any parish with a population of not less than 46,000 persons and not more than 48,500 persons according to the most recent federal decennial census (Lincoln Parish).
- (3) Any parish in which a rural institutional provider, as defined through population range references in <u>present law</u> and <u>proposed law</u>, is located (Evangeline, Jefferson Davis, and St. Landry parishes).

<u>Present law</u> defines "rural institutional provider" as a licensed hospital, other than one defined as a rural hospital by <u>present law</u> (R.S. 40:1189.3), that had no more than 60 hospital beds on Nov. 1, 2020, and meets the location criteria provided in <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> revises <u>present law</u> to include within the definition of "rural institutional provider" any licensed hospital, other than one defined as a rural hospital by <u>present law</u> (R.S. 40:1189.3), that meets the location criteria provided in <u>present law</u> and <u>proposed law</u>, existed on November 1, 2020, and has no more than 60 hospital beds.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Health and Welfare</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:
- Include within the definition of "rural institutional provider" provided in present law any licensed hospital, other than one defined as a rural hospital by present law (R.S. 40:1189.3), that meets the location criteria provided in present law and proposed law, existed on Nov. 1, 2020, and has no more than 60 hospital beds.
