<u>Present law</u> provides that the crime of carjacking is punishable by imprisonment at hard labor for between two and 20 years without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides for increased penalty of not less than 11 nor more than 20 years when the crime of carjacking is committed with a firearm or other dangerous weapon.
