| Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: |
| Section 1. R.S. 14:30(A)(13) is enacted to read as follows: |
| §30. First degree murder |
| A. First degree murder is the killing of a human being: |

| (13) When the offender has the specific intent to kill or to inflict great bodily |
| harm upon a victim who is the minor child of the offender. |

Abstract: Adds minor children of the offender to the list of specific victims of the crime of first degree murder.

<u>Present law</u> defines first degree murder as the killing of a human being when certain circumstances exist or when the specific intent to kill or to inflict great bodily harm is directly related to the victim's status.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

<u>Present law</u> provides that persons convicted of first degree murder shall be punished by death or life imprisonment at hard labor without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds minor children of the offender to the list of specific victims of the crime of first degree murder.
