HOUSE BILL NO. 869

HIGHWAYS/INTERSTATE: Designates portions of certain highways as memorial highways

1 AN ACT

2 To designate a portion of United States Highway 90 in Jefferson Davis Parish as the
3 "Winston Guillory Memorial Highway"; to designate a portion of Louisiana
4 Highway 14 in Jefferson Davis Parish as the "Marion "Butch" Fox Memorial
5 Highway"; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The portion of United States Highway 90 from mile marker sixty-three
8 to sixty-four in Jefferson Davis Parish shall be known and hereby designated as the
9 "Winston Guillory Memorial Highway".

10 Section 2. The portion of Louisiana Highway 14 from Louisiana Highway 380 to 4th
11 Street in Lake Arthur, Louisiana, in Jefferson Davis Parish shall be known and hereby
12 designated as the "Marion "Butch" Fox Memorial Highway".

13 Section 3. The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are
14 hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation
15 provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's
16 actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to
17 exceed the sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.

Designates the portion of U.S. Hwy. 90 in Jefferson Davis Parish as the "Winston Guillory Memorial Highway". Also, designates the portion of La. Hwy. 14 in Jefferson Davis Parish as the "Marion "Butch" Fox Memorial Highway".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this highway designation provided local or private monies are received by DOTD equal to its actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of \$550 per sign.
