Page 1 of 1 Provides relative to franchise fee audits and dispute resolution of certain video service providers

Present Law establishes a franchise fee, of up to 5% of gross revenues, be imposed by local governments for licensees of cable services and video programming provided through wireline facilities located at least in part in the public rights of way. Present law excludes certain video programming from the local franchise tax. Proposed law adds to the list of exclusions streaming services and direct broadcast satellite services.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

Proposed law may result in a decrease in local funds revenue by excluding streaming services and direct broadcast satellite services from the definitions of cable service and video programming. To the extent that a local government is currently imposing a franchise tax on streaming services and direct broadcast satellite and can no longer do so, local revenue will decrease. If a local government is not currently taxing these services, then there will be no change in local revenue.
