
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2022 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Commerce to Original House Bill No. 240
by Representative Emerson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 3 through 5 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

3 "provisional license for massage therapy graduates; to require notification to a client;
4 to provide for a sunset date; and to provide for related matters."

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, at the end of line 8, insert a semicolon ";" and "provisional licensure"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, delete lines 13 through 15 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

9 "board. The provisional license shall be active for one three-month term and shall
10 not be renewed. Any facility that employs a massage therapist who is operating
11 under a provisional license shall notify a client of the licensure status of a
12 provisionally-licensed massage therapist prior to the client receiving any services
13 from that massage therapist.

14 Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall cease to be effective on December 31,
15 2025."
