<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 39:1538) provides with respect to claims against the state and its agencies. The state is liable for claims in the same manner and to the same extent as a private individual under like circumstances.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 39:1535) provides for the duties of the office of risk management, including the management of all tort claims made against the state or any state agency.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the office of risk management to confirm or deny coverage of any insurance or related coverage document issued upon request of an agency, department, or claimant.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes an agency, department, or claimant to request written reasons for a denial of coverage by the office of risk management.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the office of risk management to provide the written reasons for a denial of coverage within 30 days of the request.

Effective August 1, 2022.
