Abstract: Prohibits a person from selling, distributing, or delivering safety equipment that fails to meet federal standards in this state.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits a person from selling safety equipment in this state, if it fails to meet the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) standards.

<u>Proposed law</u> applies to safety equipment used in the commercial construction or maintenance industry.

A person who violates <u>proposed law</u> shall incur a fine of at least \$100 and no more than \$500 for each violation and is in violation of the unfair and deceptive trade practices in <u>present law</u>.
