A RESOLUTION

2 To commend and congratulate Josie Gale Frank upon her induction into the St. Landry 3 Parish Democratic Party Hall of Fame. WHEREAS, Ms. Frank believes education is essential to living a full life; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Ms. Frank graduated from Charles Drew High School in Eunice, Louisiana, and went on to graduate with a Bachelor of Arts from Clark University in 6 Worcester, Massachusetts as one of only nine black students on the New England campus; 8 and 9 WHEREAS, furthering her education, Ms. Frank graduated from Coppin State 10 College in Baltimore, Maryland, with a Masters of Arts and from Southern University Law 11 Center with a Juris Doctorate, and has acquired additional credits in Environmental Law from Tulane University Law School; and 12 13 WHEREAS, Ms. Frank, a true trailblazer, is the first female of African decent to 14 accomplish the following: to be licensed to practice law in Eunice, Louisiana; to work as an assistant district attorney in the 27th Judicial District Court; to qualify and run for St. Landry 15 16 Parish Assessor; to be elected to the St. Landry School Board, serving as president for the 17 2013-2014 session; to work as a hearing officer in the 27th Judicial District Court; and to 18 be a certified Mediator and Arbitrator in the southwest area of our state; and

WHEREAS, while Ms. Frank was not victorious in some of her campaigns for public
office, she sees herself as a calculated risk taker, considers all experiences as stepping
stones, and strongly believes that the many faces of color reflected in today's elected officials
resulted in part from her efforts to create an equal playing field for females and candidates
of color in St. Landry Parish and the state; and
WHEREAS, Ms. Frank served as the first president of the board of the St. Landry-
Evangeline Women United Organization; the 2019 president of the St. Landry-Evangeline
United Way agency; and as vice president for the Board for Southwest Louisiana Healthcare
Clinic serving the medically under served in the area; and
WHEREAS, Ms. Frank considers her greatest assignment is that of mother and has
tremendous pride in her role as mentor to her sons Pride Doran and Jeremiah Emerson Bel
and her grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and
WHEREAS, every day Ms. Frank strives to live by her motto of doing her best as
long as she can with what she has to offer for the benefit of as many as possible, creating her
legacy by sharing her time, talents, and treasures with others; and
WHEREAS, the St. Landry Democratic Parish Executive Committee biennially
considers persons of high ethical and moral character who have promoted the principles of
constitutional equality, personal liberty, economic opportunity, and government and fisca
responsibility who has positively influenced the entire parish and the state; and
WHEREAS, as recipient of its Lifetime Achievement Award, the St. Landry Parish
Democratic Party considers Ms. Frank to be a person who recognizes and respects the
diversity of all Americans and promotes the common unity of all, leading her political party
and displaying strong leadership throughout her career; and
WHEREAS, Josie Gale Frank demonstrates a devotion to all of the principles of the
St. Landry Parish Democratic Party with a lifetime of efforts championing principles that
are so essential to the ideas of American democracy; and
