2	To commend and congratulate Harold L. Taylor upon his induction into the St. Landry
3	Parish Democratic Party Hall of Fame.
4	WHEREAS, throughout his life Harold has been involved in community service in
5	his hometown of Palmetto, Louisiana; and
6	WHEREAS, at the age of thirteen, one of his first community projects, and the one
7	that cemented his lifelong desire to help others, was a project wherein he assisted in the
8	organizing of a community volunteer fire department, served as a volunteer fireman, and was
9	elected to its first board of directors; and
10	WHEREAS, following college, Harold returned to the village of Palmetto and at the
11	age of twenty-two was elected to the town council and ten years later was elected its mayor;
12	and
13	WHEREAS, during his thirty-year tenure in elected office, he organized community
14	projects to improve the lives of the residents in St. Landry Parish, including extending the
15	community water system to service the communities around Palmetto which benefitted
16	hundreds of families, improving roads, and establishing a community scholarship program
17	for graduating high school seniors; and
18	WHEREAS, Mr. Taylor also established and operated a food bank, sponsored a

1	community beautification project in Palmetto, assisted a local church in establishing an
2	educational summer enrichment program, and was instrumental in bringing healthcare
3	services to his local community; and
4	WHEREAS, for his years of service to his community, Mr. Taylor was recognized
5	in Washington, D.C. as a visionary leader by the National Association of Small-Town
6	Communities; and
7	WHEREAS, in 2002, Mr. Taylor retired from public service and joined Louisiana
8	Healthcare Group, a healthcare company he co-founded that provides in-home healthcare
9	services; and
10	WHEREAS, Mr. Taylor has served on many nonprofit boards over his career and is
11	currently serving on the board of the Opelousas General Health System Foundation, St.
12	Landry Foundation, and the Harold & Ammy Taylor Foundation; and
13	WHEREAS, the St. Landry Democratic Parish Executive Committee periodically
14	considers persons of high ethical and moral character who have promoted the principles of
15	constitutional equality, personal liberty, economic opportunity, and government and fiscal
16	responsibility and has positively influenced the entire parish and the state; and
17	WHEREAS, as recipient of its Lifetime Achievement Award, the St. Landry
18	Democratic Party considers Mr. Taylor to be a person who recognizes and respects the
19	diversity of all Americans and promotes the common unity of all, leading his political party
20	and displaying strong leadership throughout his career; and
21	WHEREAS, Harold L. Taylor demonstrates a devotion to all of the principles of the
22	St. Landry Democratic Party with a lifetime championing principles that are so essential to
23	the ideas of American democracy; and
24	WHEREAS, during the Lifetime Achievement Banquet to be held on April 7, 2022,
