SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 29

SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH. Designates April 5, 2022, as University of Louisiana System Day at the Senate.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To designate Tuesday, April 5, 2022, as University of Louisiana System Day at the Senate.
3	WHEREAS, the University of Louisiana (UL) System, one of the largest university
4	systems in the nation, serves more than 90,000 students across its nine-member institutions;
5	and
6	WHEREAS, the UL System's work is supported by a strategic framework of
7	commitment to academic excellence; economic development and innovation; and financial
8	stewardship and accountability which will lead to the most educated generation in
9	Louisiana's history; and
10	WHEREAS, the UL System awards approximately 16,500 degrees annually,
11	providing more than sixty percent of the state's teachers, fifty-five percent of the state's
12	nurses, and more than fifty percent of the state's engineers; and
13	WHEREAS, more than a third of Louisiana's state senators are graduates of a UL
14	System member institution; and
15	WHEREAS, the UL System member institutions have a \$10.9 million annual
16	economic impact on the state of Louisiana, enriching the universities' home communities and
17	the adjoining parishes; and
18	WHEREAS, the UL System has launched several initiatives designed to improve the

lives of Louisianians including Compete LA, an initiative that assists the 653,000
Louisianians with some college credit but no degrees; and
WHEREAS, Compete LA participants receive one-on-one coaching and discounted
tuition to help them earn their academic credentials; and
WHEREAS, the UL System also established the Reginald F. Lewis Scholars Program
for the purpose of enhancing the educational experience of black males throughout the UL
System; and
WHEREAS, the Reginald F. Lewis Scholars are matched with academic, social, and
community opportunities to ensure persistence through college and to prepare them to be the
leaders of tomorrow; and
WHEREAS, in March 2022, the UL System unveiled a multi-year project defining
the core competencies every future graduate of a UL System institution will have attained;
and
WHEREAS, those competencies will prepare every UL System graduate for life and
career success regardless of how technology shapes the future of work; and
WHEREAS, through the many challenges of the past two years, the member
institutions of the UL System, each with a distinct mission and history, have remained
steadfast in providing excellent educational experiences to their students across the state.
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
does hereby designate Tuesday, April 5, 2022, as University of Louisiana System Day at the
Senate and does hereby commend the University of Louisiana System for the commitment
to creating the most educated generation in Louisiana's history.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to
Dr. Jim Henderson, University of Louisiana System President.
