Amendments proposed by House Committee on Commerce to Original House Bill No. 586

**1** AMENDMENT NO. 1**2** On page 1, delete lines 18 through 20 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:**3** "(4) "Criminal history record information" means all state records of arrest,  
**4** prosecution, conviction, including those which have been expunged or dismissed  
**5** pursuant to Code of Criminal Procedure Articles 893 or 894, and national records  
**6** which shall include fingerprints of the applicant, biometrics, and other identifying  
**7** information, if so requested by the department."**8** AMENDMENT NO. 2**9** On page 2, delete lines 1 through 3 in their entirety**10** AMENDMENT NO. 3**11** On page 2, between lines 19 and 20, insert the following:**12** "(3) The commission shall be entitled to the criminal history record and  
**13** identification files of the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and  
**14** Information, located within the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, of any  
**15** person who is licensed or is applying to be licensed as a real estate broker. Finger  
**16** prints, biometrics, and other identifying information of the applicant shall be  
**17** submitted to the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information for  
**18** qualification and registry, and the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and  
**19** Information shall, upon request of the bureau and after receipt of such finger print  
**20** card and other identifying information from the applicant, make available to the  
**21** bureau all arrest and conviction information contained in the Louisiana Bureau of  
**22** Criminal Identification and Information's criminal history record and identification  
**23** files which pertain to the applicant for licensure. In addition, the fingerprints shall  
**24** be forwarded by the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information to  
**25** the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a national criminal history record check.**26** (4) In accordance with the authority provided for in this Chapter, the costs  
**27** of providing the information required in accordance with this Section shall be  
**28** charged by the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information, as  
**29** specified in R.S. 15:587(B) to the bureau for furnishing information contained in the  
**30** Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information's criminal history  
**31** records and identification files, including any additional cost of providing the  
**32** national criminal history records check, which pertains to the applicant. The bureau  
**33** may impose any or all such fees or costs on the applicant."**34** AMENDMENT NO. 4**35** On page 3, line 23, after "salesperson" and before "who" insert "or broker"**36** AMENDMENT NO. 5**37** On page 3, line 24, after "consent" and before "and", delete "to, pass," and insert in lieu  
**38** thereof "to"
