McMath

Present law provides that a local school system professional employee who participated in the health insurance program of his employing school systems for not less than twenty years who became a state employee in the state Dept. of Education, Special School District or in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of youth services on or after January 1, 2002, but not later than March 29, 2004, shall be eligible, upon retirement to maintain enrollment in the office of group benefits program with a state contribution of 75% of his premium.

Proposed law includes active employees of the state Department of Education, special school district who were employed on or after August 1, 2012, but not later than January 1, 2013, to those eligible, upon retirement to maintain enrollment in the office of group benefits with a state contribution of 75% of his premium.

Effective August 1, 2022.
