Enacts the Louisiana Healthcare Workforce Training Law

Proposed law creates a state medical contract program with medical schools and teaching health centers and other providers to increase the number of students and residents receiving education/training in nursing and in primary care specialties of family medicine, internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, and pediatrics to maximize the delivery of primary care and family physician services to certain geographic areas of Louisiana. Proposed law provides that LDH shall administer the program, and shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the program.

Proposed law creates the Louisiana Healthcare Workforce Education and Training Council (council) within LDH, and provides for membership and duties of the council. Duties include; 1). No member of the council shall receive a salary, however members of the council shall be reimbursed for travel and other expenses incurred in performance of their duties.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Requiring LDH to enter into contracts on behalf of the state with various accredited medical schools and teaching health centers to increase the number of primary care physicians, physician assistants, nurses, and other healthcare professionals educated, trained, and practicing in the state is anticipated to result in a significant but indeterminable increase in state general fund expenditures annually. Presumably the cost related to the education of additional students recommended by the council will be funded by LDH though contracts with institutions that train certain primary care specialties. measure creates a state medical contract program to be administered by LDH, and creates the Louisiana Healthcare Workforce Education and Workforce Council (council) within LDH to provide support and recommendations relative to healthcare workforce education and training initiatives with funding appropriated from the legislature.
