Abstract: Prohibits COVID-19 vaccination mandates issued by the state and local governmental subdivisions.

Proposed law prohibits the state, political subdivisions, parishes, municipalities, and other local governmental subdivisions of the state from issuing or enforcing proof of COVID-19 vaccination requirements for entry into public or private entities.

Proposed law prohibits the state, political subdivisions, parishes, municipalities, and other local governmental subdivisions of the state from issuing or enforcing proof of COVID-19 vaccination requirements to receive goods or services of any kind from public or private entities.

Proposed law provides that any mandate adopted in contravention of proposed law shall be considered contrary to the public policy of this state.

Proposed law provides that the provisions of proposed law shall not apply to any COVID-19 vaccination mandate that is required by federal law or regulation.

Proposed law states that proposed law shall not be interpreted to prohibit or impede on the rights of a private business or other private entity wishing to implement any COVID-19 vaccination policy, procedure, or requirement.
