Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 22:868(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §868. Limiting actions; jurisdiction; venue
D. The provisions of Subsection A of this Section shall not prohibit a forum or venue selection clause in a policy form that is not subject to approval by the Department of Insurance pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 22:861(F) regarding special commercial entities.

Present law provides that no insurance contract made in this state shall contain any condition, stipulation, or agreement depriving La. courts of jurisdiction or venue of action against the insurer.

Proposed law provides that insurers negotiating with and insuring special commercial entities shall be exempt from the form filing and approval requirements under the provisions of present law (R.S. 22:861(F)), regarding special commercial entities.
