2 WHEREAS, now in its fourth year, *Newsweek* has published its list of the World's
3 Best Hospitals in twenty-seven countries including: USA, Germany, Japan, South Korea,
4 France, Italy, United Kingdom, Spain, Brazil, Canada, India, Australia, Mexico, The
5 Netherlands, Austria, Thailand, Switzerland, Sweden, Belgium, Finland, Norway, Denmark,
6 Israel, Singapore, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, and Columbia; and

7 WHEREAS, these countries were selected based on multiple comparability factors,
8 such as standard of living and life expectancy, population size, number of hospitals, and data
9 availability; and

10 WHEREAS, evaluation of the hospitals is based on three data sources:
11 recommendations from medical experts (doctors, hospital managers, and healthcare
12 professionals), results from public surveys (survey of patient satisfaction with
13 hospitalizations), and medical key performance indicators on hospitals (data on quality of
14 treatment and hygiene measures); and

15 WHEREAS, more than eighty thousand medical experts are invited to participate in
16 the survey and asked to recommend hospitals in their own country as well as in other
17 countries; however, the experts are barred from recommending their own employer/hospital;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, for the second year in a row, Woman's Hospital has been named as one
20 of the top hospitals in the world and, in 2022, is listed as one of the top five gynecology and
21 maternity hospitals in the world and the only one in the United States.

22 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
23 recognize and congratulate the employees and medical staff of Woman's Hospital for being
24 ranked as one of the top five gynecology and maternity hospitals in the world and the top
25 gynecology and maternity hospital in the United States of America.
