Upon the consent of the caregiver, a healthcare provider who is 16 17 providing pediatric care to an infant shall screen the caregiver for postpartum depression or related mental health disorders in accordance with the 18 19 recommendations of the American Academy of Pediatrics if in the exercise of their professional medical judgment the health care provider believes that such screening 20 21 would be in the best interest of the patient. Screenings pursuant to this Subsection 22 shall not create either a physician-patient relationship between the healthcare provider and the caregiver or any continuing obligation to provide medical services 23 24 or referral by the healthcare provider."
