Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to Original Senate Bill No. 40 by Senator McMath

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 8, delete "**A person providing foster care services**" and insert "**A. Except**
3 **as provided in Subsection B of this Section,**"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 9, after "**603,**" insert "**the Department of Children and Family Services**"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 10, delete "**foster home**" and insert "**custody of the state**"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, line 11, after "**(1)**" delete "**A**" and insert "**For a child age fourteen or older, a**"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 1, line 13, after "**(2)**" delete "**If the child**" and insert "**For a child younger than**
12 **age fourteen or a child who**"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 6

14 On page 1, between lines 14 and 15, insert the following:

15 **"B. If the Department of Children and Family Services is unable**
16 **to comply with the provisions of Subsection A of this Section due to the**
17 **child's incarceration, elopement, physical or mental disability, or**
18 **specialized placement where the child cannot be transported, or upon**
19 **approval of the court, the department shall obtain the special**
20 **identification card or photograph no later than ninety days from the**
21 **date the condition preventing compliance ceases to exist.**"
