Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to Original House Bill No. 508 by Representative Gregory Miller

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "R.S. 46:1844(O)(3)" and insert "R.S. 46:1844(N)(5)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, delete lines 8 though 18 in their entirety and on page 2 delete lines 1 through 11  
6 in their entirety and insert the following:

7 "Section 1. R.S. 46:1844(N)(5) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §1844. Basic rights for victim and witness

9 N. Duties of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections. (1) In cases  
10 where the sentence is the death penalty, the victim's family shall have the right to be  
11 notified by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections of the time, date, and  
12 place of the execution, and a minimum of two representatives of the victim's family  
13 shall have the right to be present.

15 (5) When an inmate who has been convicted of a crime of violence as  
16 defined in R.S. 14:2(B) or a sex offense as defined in R.S. 15:541 is eligible for  
17 release pursuant to R.S. 15:571.3, the Department of Public Safety and Corrections  
18 shall notify the victim or the victim's family, all persons who have filed a victim  
19 registration and notification form, the appropriate law enforcement agency, and the  
20 appropriate district attorney no later than sixty days prior to the inmate's release."
