Abstract: Prohibits indication of political party of judicial candidates on ballots.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the political party designation of a candidate shall be listed on the primary or general election ballot on the same line and immediately after or below the candidate's name.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but prohibits listing the political party designation of judicial candidates on ballots.

Effective Feb. 15, 2023.
