14	matrimony to Junior Turk on May 26, 1951, and during their blessed marriage of forty-two
15	years, four children were born; and
16	WHEREAS, Jewelene Turk, fondly called "Ms. Turk" was a homemaker who also
17	served as the seamstress for the community, then worked at the Louisiana Army
18	Ammunition Plant for several years, and upon retiring, managed several local laundromats,
