5	WHEREAS, the people of Louisiana pride themselves on giving back to the
6	community and contributing to the improvement of the quality of life of all citizens; and
7	WHEREAS, the mission of CASA is to give every child who has been abused or
8	neglected the opportunity to thrive and establish permanence with quality advocacy from a
9	CASA volunteer; and
10	WHEREAS, the CASA programs in Louisiana, in association with the National
11	CASA Association, speak for the best interests of abused and neglected children; CASA
12	volunteers are trained citizens appointed by a judge to represent these children; and
13	WHEREAS, there are seventeen CASA programs serving sixty-one parishes across
14	the state, with donated service hours by CASA volunteers valued at \$1.5 million; and
15	WHEREAS, there were 47,091 reports of child abuse or neglect in Louisiana in
16	2021; and
17	WHEREAS, approximately 5,700 of Louisiana's children were unable to live safely
18	with their families and had been placed in foster homes and institutions; and

1	WHEREAS, in 2021, approximately 3,500 Louisiana children were served by
2	approximately 1,600 CASA volunteers who provided more than 53,000 hours of volunteer
3	service to Louisiana's foster children; and
4	WHEREAS, Sara Ghere, a CASA volunteer with CASA of Terrebonne has been
5	named CASA Advocate of the Year in recognition of her exemplary service; and
6	WHEREAS, Louisiana's CASA programs and all CASA volunteers merit a special
7	measure of commendation for the outstanding work that they do on behalf of the abused and
8	neglected children of Louisiana.
9	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
10	commend the Louisiana Court Appointed Special Advocate programs across the state and
11	Sara Ghere as well as all the CASA volunteers who give tirelessly of their time and energy
12	to serve as powerful voices for children.
