2	To amend and reenact R.S. 16:51(A)(1), (5), (7), (14), (15), (16), (18), (19), (21), (24), (29),		
3	(32), (36), and (37), relative to assistant district attorneys; to provide for additional		
4	assistant district attorneys for certain judicial districts; to provide for an effective		
5	date; and to provide for related matters.		
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:		
7	Section 1. R.S. 16:51(A)(1), (5), (7), (14), (15), (16), (18), (19), (21), (24), (29),		
8	(32), (36), and (37) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:		
9	§51. Assistant district attorneys		
10	A. The district attorney of each judicial district and of the parish of Orleans		
11	shall appoint a first assistant district attorney and such other assistant district		
12	attorneys for his respective judicial district or for the parish of Orleans as may be		
13	necessary, the total number of assistant district attorneys in each judicial district and		
14	in the parish of Orleans to be not less than as hereinafter set forth:		
15	(1) In the First Judicial District, twenty-seven thirty-five assistant district

- 2 provided that funding for the additional thirty-seven assistant district attorney positions is
- 3 appropriated and payable out of the state general fund in the general appropriations bill for

Abstract: Provides for new assistant district attorney positions for various judicial districts in the state.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the number of assistant district attorneys for the various judicial districts.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the number of assistant district attorneys in particular judicial districts as follows:

- (1) 1st JDC <u>from</u> 27 <u>to</u> 35.
- (2) 5th JDC $\underline{\text{from}} 6 \underline{\text{to}} 7$.
- (3) 7th JDC $\underline{\text{from}} 5 \underline{\text{to}} 6$.
- (4) 14th JDC $\underline{\text{from}} 23 \underline{\text{to}} 25$.
- (5) 15th JDC <u>from</u> 19 to 28.
- (6) 16th JDC $\underline{\text{from}} 21 \underline{\text{to}} 23$.
- (7) 18th JDC $\underline{\text{from}}$ 10 to 12.
- (8) 19th JDC <u>from</u> 48 <u>to</u> 53.
- (9) 21st JDC <u>from</u> 18 to 19.
- (10) 24th JDC $\underline{\text{from}}$ 52 to 54.
- (11) 29th JDC $\underline{\text{from}} 9 \underline{\text{to}} 10.$
- (12) 32nd JDC <u>from</u> 19 <u>to</u> 20.
- (13) 36th JDC $\underline{\text{from}} 4 \underline{\text{to}} 5$.
- (14) 37th JDC $\underline{\text{from}} 2 \underline{\text{to}} 3$.

Effective on August 1, 2022, provided that funding for the additional 37 assistant district attorney positions is appropriated and payable out of the state general fund in the general appropriations bill for the state.
