13	(viii) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any surplus			
14	monies in the special fund of DeSoto Parish within the Forty-Second Judicial District			
15	may be transferred to the criminal court fund on an as needed basis upon the motion

1	X. In the Forty-Second Judicial District, upon the motion of the district
2	attorney and order of the judges sitting en banc, surplus monies in the special fund
3	shall be transmitted by the governing authority of the parish to the criminal court
4	fund of the Forty-Second Judicial District. As used in this Subsection, "special fund"
5	means the special fund provided for in Subsection D of this Section, and "surplus
6	monies" means the amount of money in the special fund in excess of fifty thousand
7	dollars at the end of the calendar year. The surplus monies which are transferred by
8	this Subsection may be used for any purpose for which the other monies in the
9	criminal court fund of the Forty-Second Judicial District Court may be used.

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Abstract: Requires any surplus witness and juror fees collected by the 42nd Judicial District to be transferred to the criminal court fund.

<u>Present law</u> requires the district court judge or judges for each judicial district to adopt a schedule of costs to be applied to each case before the court. These costs shall be placed in special funds (separately, a juror fund and a witness fund) to be maintained by the proper governing authorities and used to pay witness and juror fees.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that all surplus monies in the special fund of DeSoto Parish within the 42nd Judicial District shall be transferred to the criminal court fund on an as needed basis upon the motion of the district attorney and order by the judges sitting en banc.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the surplus monies which are transferred pursuant to <u>proposed</u> <u>law</u> may be used for any purpose for which the other monies in the criminal court fund of the 42nd Judicial District Court may be used.
