<u>Proposed law</u> requires each board, commission, or agency in the executive branch or governed by <u>present law</u> provisions of Title 37, Professions and Occupations, that issues a permit or license to post on its website:

- (1) Detailed instructions regarding the information needed to complete the application process.
- (2) Contact information for the individual within the board, commission, or agency responsible for responding to inquiries about the application process.
- (3) Information regarding the anticipated time line for review of an application.
- (4) The report prepared for the oversight committee or subcommittee pursuant to proposed law.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires each board, commission, or agency to annually submit to its respective legislative oversight committee or subcommittee a report containing the number of permits and licenses applied for, number of permits or licenses issued, and the time lines for approval of an application.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires each board, commission, or agency to post the required information and report on the website of the department of which it is a part of if it does not have a website.

Effective August 1, 2022.
