**Abstract:** Provides for new assistant district attorney positions for various judicial districts in the state.

Present law provides for the number of assistant district attorneys for the various judicial districts.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the number of assistant district attorneys in particular judicial districts as follows:

- (1) 1st JDC <u>from</u> 27 to 35.
- (2) 5th JDC from 6 to 7.
- (3) 7th JDC from 5 to 6.
- (4) 14th JDC <u>from</u> 23 to 25.
- (5) 15th JDC <u>from</u> 19 to 28.
- (6) 16th JDC from 21 to 23.
- (7) 18th JDC <u>from</u> 10 to 12.
- (8) 19th JDC <u>from</u> 48 to 53.
- (9)  $21 \text{ st JDC } \underline{\text{from}} \ 18 \underline{\text{to}} \ 19.$
- (10) 24th JDC  $\underline{\text{from}}$  52 to 54.
- (11) 29th JDC from 9 to 10.
- (12) 32nd JDC <u>from</u> 19 to 20.
- (13) 36th JDC  $\underline{\text{from}} 4 \underline{\text{to}} 5$ .
- (14) 37th JDC  $\underline{\text{from}} 2 \underline{\text{to}} 3$ .

Effective on August 1, 2022, provided that funding for the additional 37 assistant district attorney positions is appropriated and payable out of the state general fund in the general appropriations bill for the state.
