- 4 On page 2, between line 12 and 13, insert:

5 "(b) Notwithstanding any provision of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph to the
6 contrary, for any position sought to be filled before July 1, 2025, by employment of a
7 retiree, the advertising and posting requirements of Subparagraph (a) of this
8 Paragraph shall be considered fulfilled if the employer complies with all of the
9 following:

(i) Posts with the designated career development entities at the beginning of
 each semester a general statement that the employer is soliciting applications for future
 employment of certified teachers.

(ii) Advertises at least once per month in the official journal of the employer's
 governing authority that the employer is soliciting applications for future employment
 of certified teachers.

(iii) Prominently displays a listing of positions that are unfilled or that are filled
 by reemployed retirees on the website of the employer's governing authority and of the
 employer, if the employer maintains a separate website."

- 26 provisions of this Section as provided in Subsection B of this Section shall thereafter
- 27 <u>be covered exclusively by the provisions of this Section.</u>"
