
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Insurance to Original House Bill No. 339
by Representative Coussan

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 5, after "plan;" insert "to provide for effectiveness;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, at the end of line 15, delete the period "." and insert a comma "," and "unless all
5 of the following apply:

6 (a) The issuer can demonstrate that it has attempted to obtain other coverage
7 information from the insured during the time period for prompt payment of claims
8 pursuant to R.S. 22:1831 et seq., but did not receive such information from the
9 insured.

10 (b) The issuer agrees to accept such other coverage information including all
11 necessary details, when submitted on behalf of the insured by a healthcare provider.

12 (c) Information regarding the outstanding request for other coverage
13 information is made available to a contracted healthcare provider in an electronic
14 format which may be accessed prior to the provider performing covered services."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 3

16 On page 1, after line 16, add the following:

17 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2023. Health insurance
18 issuers shall make a good faith effort to comply with the provisions of R.S. 22:1836(A)(3)(c)
19 as enacted by Section 1 of this Act by January 1, 2023, but shall comply no later than July
20 1, 2023."
