Proposed law provides for the re-creation of the Department of the Treasury and all of its statutory entities effective June 30, 2022 in accordance with the "sunset law", R.S. 49:191. Proposed law institutes a new termination date beginning July 1, 2026 for the department and all of its statutory entities to be fully terminated by July 1, 2027 without extending the recreation.
