 RE SEE FISC NOTE
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Provides for the reorganization and modernization of the Administrative Procedure Act. (8/1/22)

<u>Proposed law</u> amends, reenacts, enact and recodify portions of the Administrative Procedures Act. <u>Proposed law</u> makes technical updates, provide public hearings, provides for publication of executive orders, provide judicial review, directs the Louisiana State Law Institute to redesignate the current provisions of specific law a new format and number scheme, make technical and conforming changes to reflect the format and number scheme provided herein, directs the Louisiana Law Institute to change references to segments of law in existing statutes and codes as necessary to reflect the redesignation of such segments.

Proposed law changes the public hearing timeframe from 35 days to 45 days. Proposed law extends the deadline to five business days.
