7 G. An employer or qualified entity who requests a background check may
8 utilize an online entity to receive fingerprint samples from an employee and perform
9 a criminal history records check in the same manner as conducted by the Louisiana
10 Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information.

11 Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall become effective on May 1,
12 2023."
