- 6 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 7 On page 2, line 3, after "into a" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 4 through

8 7 in their entirety and insert "disaster repair contract may cancel the contract within ten days

- 9 of entering into the contract."
- 10 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 4</u>
- 11 On page 2, line 8, after "<u>contract</u>" and before "<u>pursuant</u>" delete "<u>or subcontract</u>"
- 12 AMENDMENT NO. 5
- 13 On page 2, between lines 16 and 17 insert the following:
- "(4) The right to cancel a contract pursuant to this Section shall expire at the
  expiration of the disaster or emergency declaration or one year from the date of the
  issuance of the disaster or emergency declaration, whichever occurs first."
- 17 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 6</u>
- 18 On page 2, after line 26, add the following:
- "E. For purposes of this Section, "disaster repair contract" means a contract
  or subcontract entered into during the six month period following a gubernatorially
  declared disaster or emergency following a natural disaster for repairs to a residential
  property affected by the natural disaster."
