Abstract: Authorizes the suspension or revocation of any recreational fishing privilege for a period of one year for charter fishing without required credentials.

<u>Present law</u> requires a charter boat fishing guide to possess a valid state charter boat fishing guide license, a valid captain's license issued by the U.S. Coast Guard, proof of liability insurance, and a valid state recreational fishing license that grants fishing privileges appropriate for his charter activity. Further provides penalties for violating these requirements.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds suspension or revocation of any recreational fishing privilege for a period of one year to the penalties available for a second or subsequent offense of charter fishing without proper credentials.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Natural Resources and</u> <u>Environment to the original bill:</u>

1. Make the penalty of license suspension and revocation available for second and subsequent offenses, rather than for third and subsequent offenses.
