Abstract: Increases the gross annual sales threshold under which a home-based preparer of low-risk foods may qualify for the exemption from food preparation laws and regulations provided by the statute known commonly as the cottage food law.

<u>Present law</u> known commonly as the cottage food law exempts home-based preparers of certain foods for sale from <u>present law</u> and <u>present administrative rule</u> relative to preparation of food for public consumption if the preparer's gross annual sales of such foods are less than \$20,000 and certain other conditions are met.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the gross annual sales threshold provided in the cottage food law from \$20,000 to \$30,000; otherwise, retains present law.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Health and Welfare</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

1. Increase the gross annual sales threshold provided in the cottage food law from \$20,000 to \$30,000.
