Provides relative to network adequacy for health insurer benefit plans. (1/1/23)

Under <u>present law</u>, health insurance plans must file annual access plans with the LA Department of Insurance (LDI) for each health plans that insurer offers in the state. <u>Present law</u> provided for an exception to filing annual access plans if the health insurance issuer had proof of accreditation. <u>Proposed law</u> eliminates that accreditation exception to filing annual access plans. Proposed law effective January 1, 2023.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Under present law, some health plans are exempted from filing annual network access plans with the LA Department of Insurance (LDI). The proposed law eliminates that exemption; thereby requiring all health plans to file annual network access plans with LDI. LDI reports that it is capable of handling any workload arising from increased filing of annual plans with existing budgetary and personnel resources.
