2 thirty-five thousand members in the United States, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands; and

3           WHEREAS, FFA membership in Louisiana continues to be strong and includes  
4 nearly eleven thousand agricultural students in two hundred and four chapters throughout  
5 the state; and

6           WHEREAS, the members of the Louisiana House of Representatives recognize the  
7 importance of agriculture to the economy of this state, as well as the importance of the  
8 education and training students in the state receive through agricultural education programs  
9 that develop competent and assertive agricultural leadership.

10          THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
11 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate Tuesday, April 26, 2022, as FFA Day at the  
12 state capitol.

13          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature  
14 of Louisiana also recognizes and commends the 2021-2022 state FFA officers as follows:
