Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to
Original House Bill No. 175 by Representative Landry

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 15:831(B)(2)" and before the comma "," delete "and to repeal"
3 R.S. 15:874(4)(d)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 4, after "treatment;" and before "to provide" insert "to provide relative to"
6 charges for prescriptions;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, at the beginning of line 12, change "(2)" to "(2)(a)"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 2, line 2, after "contrary," delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 3 through
11 5 in their entirety and insert the following:

12 "an inmate housed at a state correctional facility shall not be required to make a
13 copayment of an amount greater than two dollars upon receiving medical or dental
14 treatment. An inmate who has two hundred dollars or less in a drawing account shall
15 not be required to make a copayment of any amount upon receiving medical or
16 dental treatment.

17 (b) Notwithstanding Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph, an inmate housed
18 at a state correctional facility shall not be charged for prescriptions written and
19 dispensed, including orders for prosthetics.
