A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing to add Article I, Section 10.2 of the Constitution of Louisiana, relative to elections; to provide for free and equal elections; and to specify an election for submission of the proposition to electors and provide a ballot proposition.

Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to add Article I, Section 10.2 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:

§10.2. Freedom of Elections

All elections shall be free and equal; and no power, civil or military, shall at any time interfere with or prevent the free exercise of the right of suffrage.

Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on November 8, 2022.

Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at said election there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as

2 Do you support an amendment to ensure that all elections are free and equal

Proposed constitution requires all elections to be fair and equal and disallows the
interference with or prevention from exercise of the right to vote by any power, civil or
military.

Specifies submission of the amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on
November 8, 2022.
