1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 13, between lines 24 and 25, insert the following:
- 3 "I. The State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education shall adopt rules
- 4 to require all approved nonpublic schools to implement bullying policies equivalent to
- 5 those required of public schools."
- 6 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 7 On page 13, line 25, change "<u>I.</u>" to "<u>J.</u>"
- 8 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 9 On page 13, line 28, after "shall be" delete the remainder of the line and insert the following:
- 10 "investigated by the state Department of Education. Upon finding a reasonable
- expectation that the individual failed to act, the department shall report the incident
- 12 to the district attorney with jurisdiction for the parish in which the school is located.
- 13 Based on the severity of the bullying inflicted on the victim, the district attorney shall
- charge the individual who failed to act with either a misdemeanor or felony offense.
- 15 Upon a conviction, the individual who failed to act"
- 16 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 4</u>
- On page 14, line 5, after "**shall be**" delete the remainder of the line and insert the following:
- 18 "investigated by the state Department of Education. Upon finding a reasonable
- 19 <u>expectation that the individual failed to act, the department shall report the incident</u>
- 20 to the district attorney with jurisdiction for the parish in which the school is located.
- Based on the severity of the bullying inflicted on the victim, the district attorney shall
- 22 charge the individual who failed to act with either a misdemeanor or felony offense,
- 23 and upon a"
