Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Original House Bill No. 1052 by Representative Landry

1 AMENDMENT NO. 12 On page 1, line 6, after "audits;" and before "and to" insert "to provide relative to repayment
3 of loans and waiver in certain circumstances;"4 AMENDMENT NO. 25 On page 2, line 4, after "this" and before "the" delete "Chapter," and insert "Section,"6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 3, after line 4, insert the following:

8 "E. The Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency
9 Preparedness shall establish application procedures and eligibility criteria for loans
10 from the fund.11 F.(1) A political subdivision may use loan proceeds for the purpose of
12 offering loan funds to private property owners to use for hazard mitigation projects
13 for buildings. Each private property owner applying for a loan pursuant to the
14 provisions of this Subsection shall demonstrate on the loan application both a need
15 for the loan and the ability to repay the loan, if required.16 (2) Repayment of a loan provided pursuant to this Subsection may be
17 collected in the same manner as property taxes.18 (3) A political subdivision that provides loans to private property owners
19 pursuant to the provisions of this Subsection may establish a graduated loan
20 forgiveness program for private property owners. Such a program shall provide for
21 both of the following, at a minimum:22 (a) Provide full loan forgiveness for households with income less than eighty
23 percent of the median income for the area in which the property is located.24 (b) Provide forgiveness of up to fifty percent of the loan for households with
25 income between eighty and one hundred percent of the median income for the area
26 in which the property is located."
