4	WHEREAS, it is with immense sadness and profound regret that the House of
5	Representatives has learned of the passing on April 9, 2022, of Betty Jean Webb Jackson;

7	WHEREAS, Betty Webb Jackson was born to Milton Webb, Sr., and Eura Dell
8	Jenkins Webb on August 22, 1943, in Homer, Louisiana; she later moved to Grambling,
9	Louisiana; and
10	WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson received a bachelor of science degree from Grambling
11	State University and a master of science degree from Louisiana Tech University; she worked
12	professionally as a licensed speech-language pathologist in Louisiana, and she held a
13	Certificate of Clinical Competence from the National Board of Examiners of the American
14	Speech-Language-Hearing Association; she also received the Fellow Award and the Honor
15	Award from the Louisiana Speech-Language-Hearing Association; and
16	WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson retired from Grambling State University in 2010 after
17	many years of dedicated service to both the university and its students; during the course of
18	her career, she served as a professor of public speaking and later as director of the Speech
19	and Hearing Clinic; and
20	WHEREAS, Betty was also deeply devout in her faith; she earned both a bachelor's
21	and master's degree in religious education and received an honorary doctorate from United

1 Theological Seminary and Bible College in Monroe, Louisiana; she served many years as 2 a part-time instructor for the seminary; and 3 WHEREAS, Betty was an active member of China Grove Missionary Baptist 4 Church, which is pastored by Revered Damian Wilson; she truly loved her church family 5 and was passionate about working with its special programs; and 6 WHEREAS, Betty was also an active and dedicated member of Epsilon Psi Omega 7 Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., where she served as a former protocol officer 8 and president; she considered becoming a "Golden Soror" of fifty years as one of the 9 happiest moments of her life; and 10 WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson civic involvement was truly inspiring; she was twice 11 named "Woman of the Year" for the Grambling State University Chapter of the American 12 Business Women's Association; additionally, she held the office of president for the 13 Interdenominational Alliance of Ministers' Wives until her passing; her favorite work was 14 evangelism, and she modeled her life after the quote, "What I am is God's gift to me, and 15 what I become will be my gift to God"; and 16 WHEREAS, Betty diligently and unconditionally loved and adored her family; she 17 is survived by her son, Michael L. Jiles, and his wife Alecia; her daughters, Yolanda Denise 18 Jefferson, and her husband Reggie, and Earline Hamilton; sister, Annie Mae Washington, 19 and her husband Lester; brother, Milton Webb, Jr., and his wife Carolyn; grandchildren, 20 Cameron, Carmen, and Marcus; godsons, Rev. Stanley Bissic, Gregory Dade, and his wife 21 Judith, Dr. Roderick Henderson, and his wife Stephanie, and Rev.
