Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Education to Original Senate Bill No. 124
by Senator Abraham

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 16, change "student" to "child enrolled in an approved home study
3 program and each child"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, delete lines 1-7, and insert the following:

6 **"(i) Immediately upon receipt of a report of attendance or upon receipt of an**
7 **application for a home study program pursuant to R.S. 17:236.1(A), provide**
8 **notification to the city, parish or other local public school system in which the child was**
9 **most recently enrolled, and if different, the public school system which the child's home**
10 **address is located. The notification shall include the child's legal name, date of birth,**
11 **and physical address. "Immediately" as used in this Item and R.S. 17:236.1(A), shall**
12 **mean within thirty days of the receipt of a report of attendance or an application."**

13 AMENDMENT NO. 3

14 On page 2, line 8, change "student" to "child"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 4

16 On page 2, line 9, change "student" to "child"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5

18 On page 2, at the beginning of line 10, change "student" to "child"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 6

20 On page 2, line 10, before "subsequently" change "student" to "child"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 7

22 On page 2, delete lines 16-18, and insert the following:

23 **"(3) No city, parish, or other local public school system shall be responsible for**
24 **ensuring the school attendance of any child whose parent has applied for an approved**
25 **home study program or has reported the attendance of the child to the department**
26 **pursuant to Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, even if such application or report of**
27 **attendance is not resubmitted each year, unless and until the parent subsequently**
28 **enrolls the child in a public school under the authority of the public school system."**
