1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 5, change "nonemergency" to "non-emergency"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 24 On page 1, line 12, change "NONEMERGENCY" to "NON-EMERGENCY"5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 2, delete lines 3 through 7 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

7 "(4) "Non-emergency medical transportation" and "NEMT" mean
8 transportation provided to a Medicaid beneficiary to or from a medically necessary
9 Medicaid-covered service. The term shall not include any non-emergency or other
10 type of transportation by ambulance."

11 AMENDMENT NO. 412 On page 2, line 8, change "Nonemergency" to "Non-emergency"13 AMENDMENT NO. 514 On page 2, line 9, change "nonemergency" to "non-emergency"15 AMENDMENT NO. 616 On page 2, line 11, change "nonemergency" to "non-emergency"17 AMENDMENT NO. 7

18 On page 2, at the end of line 13, insert the following:

19 "The Medicaid beneficiary or his representative shall confirm that the beneficiary has
20 no other means of transportation."

22 On page 2, delete lines 14 through 22 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

23 "B. Non-emergency medical transportation to or from a pharmacy, a nursing
24 facility, hospice care, or an appointment for Special Supplemental Nutrition Program
25 for Women, Infants, and Children services at an office of public health location is
26 prohibited."
